Supervisor Marnell called the Budget Workshop meeting to order at 3:00 P.M.

Schroon Lake Ambulance Squad

Lynn Donaldson stated she had good news that the Schroon Lake Ambulance Squad would remain the same with the 12 hours, 7 days a week for the next two years, provided they meet their calls at night.

Lynn Donaldson stated they would like to purchase a Lucas 2 Chest Compression system which would be easier to maneuver in a emergency, she is looking into a grant for this.

Chris Stone stated they could set up a Capital Reserve Account for the purchase of a new Ambulance through the Town that way if they dissolve from the Fire Department the money will be there for the purchase of a new ambulance. The Town is working on a new contract with the Fire Department. Chris stated that the Town can not pay for Legal and Audit, Association Dues and any salaries, taking out \$7,200.00. The Town will leave the \$245,000.00 in the budget and look into a reserve account

which will come out of the fund balance.

Schroon Lake Chamber of Commerce

Supervisor Marnell stated this year he would like to give the Chamber \$1,000.00 more and put \$1,000.00 more into celebrations for more fireworks on the 4th of July. The Chamber is in the negative and needs to find ways to increase their revenues if they are to continue.

Supervisor Marnell stated if the Chamber does not show improvement this year he would like to decrease their budget in 2018 significantly. Supervisor Marnell stated ROOST had just given all the Towns \$2,500.00 and that North Hudson should be contributing their portion to the Chamber.

Parks Department

Patrick Shaughnessy stated that the Parks Department was in need of some new equipment.
