

Special Town Board Meeting held April 3, 2017 at 3:00 P.M. at the Town Hall in

Schroon Lake N.Y.

Supervisor Marnell called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.M.

Jamie Veitch stated that he had a list of what he would like to accomplish this year at the Golf Course. The normal greens, fairway and tee mowing; sand bunker maintenance; tree pruning and thinning will be done along with:

Course improvement projects:

1. Complete irrigation wiring and controls, minor fairway repair
2. Complete new maintenance building
3. Run irrigation from #4 fairway to # 3 green and #4 tees (about 300' of 1 1/2 inch plastic)
4. Stabilize edges of #1, 2, 3 and 6 sand bunkers, trying a new recycled product- Bunker Border
5. Determine the type of tree for the White Pine planned replacement, potentially replace a downed tree
6. Plan and purchase conduit #6 fairway leveling
7. Continue TMC spraying program, add a grub preventative to reduce sod damage
8. Disassemble existing maintenance shed and begin the reshaping of #9 tees

-Equipment:

No major additions, however, be prepared to lease a fairway mower if necessary and look into an overall lease program for major pieces of equipment.
